Week 1	Jun 21 to Jun 25	Young Authors: The children will learn about and explore books written by specific authors and illustrators (including Eric Carle, Leoni, Johnson, Dr. Suess, Jan Brett, Ehlert, Numeroff, McKee, and many more!) The children will also explore folk tales, fables and fantasy as well as construct their own books. They will also study and imitate the styles of various illustrators. The session will culminate with a book faire for the parents, that the children will host exhibiting their own "books".	Fri July 2nd 11-12noon Book Faire
Week 2	Jun 28 to July 2*		
Week 3	July 5 to July 9	Young Artists: The children would learn about several artists including Van Gough, Rivera, Picasso, George Rodrigue, Kahlo, O'Keefe, Casset, Matisse, Pollack, Seurat, Mondrian etc. The children will use many types of media and explore various techniques. The camp will culminate with an Art Show for the parents that the children will host.	Fri July 16th 11-12noon Art Show
Week 4	July 12 to July 16*		
Week 5	July 19 to July 23	Young Scientists: The children will explore physical sciences through experimentation, prediction, observation and conclusion. The children will use many household and classroom items to find out how the world works. They will explore gravity, change of state, buoyancy, friction, condensation, chemical reactions, x-rays & bones etc. The session will culminate with an interactive science fair that the children will host for their parents. Week 6	July 26 to July 30*		
Week 7	Aug 2 to Aug 6	Young Chefs: The children will participate in various "hands-on" cooking experiences. They will explore foods from many cultures and use many different tools to prepare food. They will also learn about healthy choices, planning grocery lists, serving techniques and table manners. The camp will culminate with a parent luncheon hosted by the children.
